FIRST BYE-LAWS OF HORSHADER DEVELOPMENT LIMITED

Associate Membership

1. Associate membership - Eligibility Condition

Subject to Clause 4 of the company's Articles of Association, Associate Membership of the Company shall be open to all individuals over 16 years of age who have:

- a) A personal interest in the HCD area.
- b) Commitment to community development trusts.
- c) Interest in renewable energy

2. It is at the discretion of the Board whether or not to admit any person/organisation to the trust.

3. An Associate of HCD can attend the Annual General Meeting but may not vote. Associates of HCD are not eligible for election as Directors.

4. Ordinary membership – Termination

- a) In addition to the circumstances outlined in Clause 8 of the Company's Articles of Association where under an Associate shall be automatically terminated, an Associate shall also cease to be an Associate in the event of that person ceasing to fulfil the eligibility condition for admission, applying at the time of his or her admission. At the discretion of the Board any such former person may be admitted as an Associate in accordance with Clause 10 of the Company's Articles of Association.
- b) The Board may at any time suspend or terminate the Membership of any Associate deemed to have acted or be acting against the interests of the Company. Any Associate or former Associate whose Memberships is suspended or terminated under this bye-law may appeal for reinstatement at the next or any subsequent general meeting of the company and attend and be heard at such meeting for the purpose of making such appeal.
