The Minibus Service

The rural transport service is a door-to-door service which is not provided through scheduled bus services, on a non-profit basis, enabling members to have access to services and amenities which they would otherwise not be able to access. The minibus is fully wheelchair accessible and equipped with an on-board mounted electric/hydraulic wheelchair lift.

The project will provide a part time driver for 5 days a week – Mon – Fri and with enough volunteer drivers we may be able to provide a service out with these times.

Shawbost Primary School morning and afternoon runs, and the Friday Nicolson Institute pupil's collection is free as part of the Support and Connect membership.

The minibus is also available to members of the public and community groups.

We aim to provide a flexible service and welcome any suggestions.

We can pick you up from your home and take you to:

- Surgery & optician appointments
- Medication collection
- Airport for mainland hospital appointments
- Provide additional services with volunteer drivers

Some journeys will be booked on a first come first served basis.

Who can access the service?

Anyone who is a member can access the service, however priority will be given to the most vulnerable members of the community. Some services may be restricted to elderly and vulnerable individuals.

How can I access the service?

Complete and return the membership registration form with a fee of £5.00 per household.

Some journeys will be booked on a first come first served basis. Standard fares will be charged to individuals.

Hiring the minibus?

The minibus can be hired anytime when it is not in use, for any event parties, sports events and group excursions.

Who can drive the minibus?

Only the Horshader minibus driver, who must accompany all hires.

The service will continue to run in evenings and weekends with the assistance of volunteer drivers (aged between 25-70, in possession of a full & clean UK drivers' licence with category D1, Midas certificate)

The Handyperson Service

What is the service?

The project employs a part time handy person to carry out basic DIY in the community, especially for the most vulnerable, to help them enjoy a better quality of life and remain as independent as possible for as long as possible.

For example, we can do:

- Fence painting
- Take in coal or peat
- Cut your grass/strim
- Minor household repairs

Who can access it?

Anyone who is a member of the project can access the service, however priority will be given to the most vulnerable members of the Horshader Community. Some services may be restricted to elderly and vulnerable individuals.

How can Laccess the service?

Complete and return the form to us with the small membership registration fee of £5.00 per household.

How do you access it?

Please contact the office and let them know the service you require, and they will schedule the job. This service will be available on a first come first served basis.

What are the Costs involved?

Those of pensionable age or with a recognised medical condition will be charged £10 per hour, otherwise the services will be charged at a rate of £20 per hour.

How do I pay?

Payment can be made by BACS, cash or cheque. Please refer to invoice for payment details.
